Non NHS Examinations

Medical examinations for special purposes, e.g. life insurance, elderly driver, HGV, PSV, pre-employment, fitness to undertake sports, fitness to travel etc; are by appointment and are subject to a charge.

Access to Medical Records

You have a right to see your health records, subject to any limitations in the law. There is a fee payable for this and all requests must be in writing and an appointment will be offered. We are registered in accordance with the Data Protection Act. You are now entitled to request on-line access to coded data within your record.

APPOINTMENTS	All appointments are a telephone call from your GP or other more appropriate clinician initially, should you be required to be seen an appointment will be booked with you.
HOME VISITS	If you are genuinely unable to attend the surgery please telephone Reception before 10.00am.
OUT OF HOURS EMERGENCIES	There is a service for urgent out of hours emergencies – please telephone our usual number 01271 372672 to hear a recorded message on who to contact.
TEST RESULTS	Please call Reception for test results between 2.00pm and 4.00pm
REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS	You are able to order your repeat prescriptions online, please register with Reception for access to www.queensmc.com , by email to D-CCG.qmcprescriptions@nhs.net , alternatively drop your request slip into the box on the Reception desk. Please allow 48 hours before collecting from the Medical Centre or 72 hours if

	collecting from the Chemist. Prescription requests will not be taken over the telephone
MEDICAL STUDENTS	Queens Medical Centre is a training practice and we will sometimes have medical students observing consultations, please let us know if you would prefer to see the doctor or nurse alone.
LANGUAGES	We use Language Line to assist with translations during consultations, although you are welcome to bring a friend or relative.
ZERO TOLERANCE	We have a zero tolerance policy for abuse and ask that all patients are polite and respectful to our staff. We will remove from our list any patient who is physically or verbally abusive or threatening towards staff or other patients.
